Virtual Workshop within the HACKDEV4IMPACT Program

27th of November

from 10h00 to 13h00

In order to enable civil society organizations providing adequate responses to the problems inherent to digital transformation and to be able to follow the trends and opportunities that will arise in the future, the entities promoting this program propose to hold a training and a diagnosis workshop for CSO's digitalization needs in the International Development sector in Portugal.

This initiative will count with the participation of Development NGOs, but also other Development partners and relevant actors at a national level. The workshop will have a training component, brought by a referenced specialist, but also a time to diagnose digital needs and opportunities.

In this way, we intend to have an overview of the Portuguese Development Organizations' reality and look at identified needs that may be of an organizational, territorial or thematic order.

This workshop will be developed within the scope of the project "Towards an open, fair and sustainable Europe in the world", related to the Portuguese Presidency of the Council of the European Union, and will culminate with the launch of an invitation to submit proposals, in which the NGOs must describe the challenge / need / problem they want to solve and how a digital investment can help to solve it.

Programa:

- Digitalization for Development: definition, strategies and guiding principles.
- Impact of new trends on civil society: the Portuguese reality, in particular, and the digital transition in PALOP (African countries whose official language is Portuguese) and Timor-Leste.
- Digital challenges and technological communities: the development of digital solutions at the service of civil society organizations.
- Diagnosis of needs and opportunities of NGOs in the digital world.
